Early work for the M1 Pacific Motorway upgrade between Tuggerah and Doyalson interchanges from Monday 23 January 2017

The Australian and NSW governments are funding the upgrade of the M1 Pacific Motorway between the Tuggerah and Doyalson interchanges to improve traffic flow and safety.

To prepare for the upgrade, Roads and Maritime Services is continuing to build the site compound at St Johns Road, Jilliby. This site is temporary and will be operational until mid 2020.

We will be working **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm** and **Saturday** between **8am** and **1pm** and expect to complete the work in **five weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

The early work involves building temporary fencing, driveways and a demountable building, removing vegetation and installing a temporary road base within the site.

Major construction on the motorway is expected to start in 2017. We will provide more information to residents and stakeholders about this as the project progresses.

How will the work affect you?

We will make every effort to minimise noise and dust. Where possible, we will minimise obstructions to driveways.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe, including reduced speed limits and traffic control on St Johns Road.
