

## Night work on Maitland Bay Drive and Picnic Parade intersection, Ettalong from Sunday 28 February

The NSW Government is investing \$7 million to upgrade the Maitland Bay Drive and Picnic Parade intersection to improve traffic flow and safety for road users.

Transport for NSW is carrying out work to build a new roundabout at the intersection.

We will be working at night between **Sunday 28 February** and **Thursday 4 March, and from Sunday 7 March to Thursday 11 March**. We will be working between **6pm and 5am** and expect to complete the work in **10 shifts**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

Work to be carried out includes:

- Building the permanent concrete roundabout
- Building concrete median pedestrian islands on Maitland Bay drive and Picnic Parade.

We have included a map below to illustrate the work location.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by carrying out noisier activities where possible before 11pm, completing the work in stages along this section of road and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and traffic controllers will be in place during work hours.

A permanent 40 km/h reduced speed limit remains in place through the work zone for the safety of motorists and workers. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
