

Mascot intersection upgrades

Start of work: Stage Two

Stage two is beginning at the intersection of Gardeners Road and Botany Road at Mascot

On **29 September 2019**, Roads and Maritime Services will begin to upgrade the intersection of Gardeners Road and Botany Road, Mascot. This will extend the right turn lane from Gardeners Road onto Botany Road, creating dual right turn lanes, a dedicated through lane, and a shared left turn/through lane.

We will be on site up to five nights a week, between 8pm and 5am, for up to 30 shifts, from Sunday 29 September until mid-December 2019.

Work on stage one of the program (the intersection of Bourke and Coward streets, Mascot) began in early September. Work to upgrade the intersections of Coward Street and Kent Road, and Ricketty Street and Kent Road is expected to start in October 2019. How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities such as concrete cutting, chain sawing and jack hammering by midnight.


