



# Mona Vale Road East Upgrade

## Traffic Changes in January 2022

Transport for NSW | January 2022

The NSW Government is investing \$140 million to upgrade Mona Vale Road between Manor Road, Ingleside and Foley Street, Mona Vale, from two lanes to four lanes to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety.

We thank you for your patience during this important work.

Work has progressed along the western end of the Mona Vale Road East upgrade from Lane Cove Road to make way for the construction of new eastbound lanes.

To continue this work we will need to carry out of hours work, *please note more information will be provided on a separate notice*, and a second traffic change on Mona Vale Road.

### Second Stage -Traffic Switch

In the December update, we mentioned two traffic switches are required to continue widening for the new westbound lanes. The first switch took place successfully in early December.

The second traffic change will take place from **Thursday 20 January** over two night shifts between **7pm and 5am**, weather permitting.

The section of the roadway to be moved starts along Mona Vale Road to tie into the existing roadway before the cemetery. The traffic will be shifted to the northern side of the existing roadway onto the new road pavement.

These changes will allow work to commence on the western side of the road which will be closed off to traffic. This work will include a contra-flow to complete the asphaltting, line marking and placement of barriers.

To help road users navigate the traffic change, we will have static signs, variable messaging signs and traffic controllers on site. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller's directions.

If the traffic switch does not happen on this date, we will reschedule works for the following week, weather permitting. We will notify in advance before we make any changes to the traffic.

### How will this work effect you?

There may be impacts to some residents during preparations for this traffic change, including noise and lighting during the out of hours work between **17 January to 21 January 2022**.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact by turning machinery and vehicles off when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from properties, where possible.

Residents who may be heavily impacted by the evening work and are eligible for alternative accommodation will be notified 36 hours before the work.

### COVID 19 Response and Recovery Order

To support industry and continue delivering critical infrastructure, the NSW Government introduced new rules last year allowing construction sites, including public infrastructure projects, to operate on weekends and public holidays up until 31 March 2022.

We have been using these new rules for some time, particularly with our weekend road closure work.

High impact noisy activities, such as rock breaking, rock hammering and pile driving will stop at 1pm. All other activities will continue through to 6pm

Upgrading Mona Vale Road will improve how you move in and around the local area.
