



## Night work on Mulgoa Road, Penrith from 1 February 2019

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly funding the \$105 million upgrade of Mulgoa Road, Penrith – from Union Road to Museum Drive.

Roads and Maritime Services has started work on this project which includes an upgrade to the railway bridge. This vital upgrade will connect road users to the Penrith CBD and ease congestion at these intersections.

As part of this upgrade, the following activities will occur at night:

- delivery of plant equipment and materials
- road surfacing work, temporary line marking, excavation, earthwork and concreting
- median strip modification on Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road
- utility investigation and relocation
- installation of pedestrian fencing, traffic barriers and signs on Castlereagh Road, Mulgoa Road, Union Road and High Street
- start of road widening on Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road
- installation of temporary pedestrian paths as required.

### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **10pm**.

### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

At times partial lane closures will be in place that may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controllers' directions.
