## **Field investigations on Castlereagh Road, Penrith from Monday 18 July to Monday 25 July 2016.**

**The Australian and NSW governments have jointly committed \$70million to develop and construct road improvements to reduce congestion and improve traffic flow along Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road adjacent to Penrith's CBD.**

Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out geotechnical field investigations to help plan the detailed design for the Jane Street and Mulgoa Road upgrade between Union Road and Museum Drive, Penrith.

The investigation work will involve the drilling of boreholes. Please refer to the map on the back of this page for the location of this work.

This work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm on Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturday**, weather permitting for a period of up to 1 week. Some night work will also be required from 9pm and 5am on Monday to Friday during this time.

### **How will the work affect you?**

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations.

### **Traffic changes**

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of road users and workers. Road users are required to follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. Pedestrians may be directed to alternative footpaths by traffic controllers.

Up to date information, including any changes and detours will be displayed on electronic message signs located along the road.

To minimise traffic disruptions, some lane closures may be in place during the night work. Please keep to the speed limit and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
