



Night work on Mulgoa Road, Penrith from 5 December 2018

The Australian and NSW Government is jointly funding \$105 million to upgrade Mulgoa Road, Penrith from Union Road to Museum Drive

Roads and Maritime Services is starting construction on Mulgoa Road, Penrith – from Union Road to Museum Drive including Railway Bridge upgrade. This upgrade will connect road users to the Penrith CBD and ease congestion at the included intersections.

We will be carrying out utility relocation work on Mulgoa Road and Castlereagh Road to facilitate the bridge construction for the upgrade.

We will be onsite between **Wednesday 5 December** and **Friday 21 December 2018**, weather permitting. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **6am**.

In an effort to complete larger amounts of work and reduce the number of night shifts impacting residents and road users, we are also carrying out continuous work from **8pm** on **Friday 7 December** until **5am Monday 10 December 2018**, weather permitting.
