

Project update for Nelson Bay Road Upgrade - Williamtown to Bobs Farm

The NSW Government is funding this \$275 million project to improve safety and travel times on Nelson Bay Road.

Transport for NSW is currently planning for the upgrade of Nelson Bay Road from Williamtown to Bobs Farm as the next priority for the Nelson Bay Road corridor. We are considering both on-line and off-line route alignment options. The project would improve safety and travel times on Nelson Bay Road.

Transport for NSW sought comments from the community and stakeholders on the proposed route options for the project in September 2019. We would like to thank everyone who took the time to consider our proposal and provide feedback.

Following a review of the comments, we have prepared a Community Consultation Report, which summarises the feedback and our responses. What happens next?

Following a review of the comments, we have decided to investigate alternative route options for the Nelson Bay Road – Williamtown to Bobs Farm upgrade that were suggested by the community and stakeholders during the consultation period. We are planning to further consult with the community about the alternative route options in late 2020.
