


Changed traffic conditions at the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection, Dubbo from Tuesday 18 May

The NSW Government is funding \$20 million to upgrade the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection to improve safety and efficiency.

Temporary traffic signals at the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection



Work on the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection is progressing well, with the next step in construction to remove the existing roundabout and install temporary traffic signals at the intersection.

During this time, right hand turn access will be restricted for vehicles turning right from the Mitchell Highway westbound lane, Mitchell Highway eastbound lane and the Newell Highway southbound lane.

The night work will be carried out between **Monday 17 May** and **Wednesday 19 May** from **8pm** to **6am**.

Work during the day will occur between **7am** and **6pm** and this stage of works is expected to be completed in **three weeks**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise impact, including completing the noisier tasks earlier in the night and staging the work along different parts of the work zone to minimise disruption in the same area.

Residents inside the traffic control area will be able to access their property, however access arrangements may be affected. Consultation with impacted residents is ongoing.

Traffic changes

Changed traffic conditions including temporary traffic control, reduced lane widths, restricted right-hand turn access, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists.

A wide load detour will be in place via Minore Road, North Street, Erskine Street, Golden Highway and Wheelers Lane. The wide load detour will be in place 24 hours a day during construction.

A heavy vehicle detour for the Mitchell Highway will be in place via Thompson Street, Erskine Street, Golden Highway and Wheelers Lane. The heavy vehicle detour will be in place 24 hours a day during construction.

Motorists are advised to allow additional travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
