

Temporary closure of Baird Street intersection from Wednesday 21 July

The Australian and NSW Governments are funding the \$40 million Newell Highway Mitchell Highway intersection upgrade, Dubbo as part of their commitment to Building a better Dubbo.

Traffic changes at the Newell Highway and Baird Street intersection in Dubbo



From **Wednesday 21 July 2021**, Transport for NSW will continue work on the Newell Highway Mitchell Highway intersection upgrade project in Dubbo. We will temporarily close the Newell Highway and Baird Street intersection to enable us to carry out road paving and steel barrier installation.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Saturday** and between **8am** and **6pm Sunday**. We expect to complete the work in **10 days**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

Baird Street will be closed at the intersection of the Newell Highway, with detours in place via East Street and Young Street.

Driveway access will be restricted for some residents and businesses along the Newell Highway inside the traffic control area, with parking available on Baird Street.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Changed traffic conditions including temporary traffic control, reduced lane widths, restricted left and right-hand turn access, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists.

Left and right-hand turn access will be restricted for vehicles turning left into Baird Street from the Newell Highway northbound lane and vehicles turning right into Baird Street from the Newell Highway southbound lane.

Motorists are advised to allow additional travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
