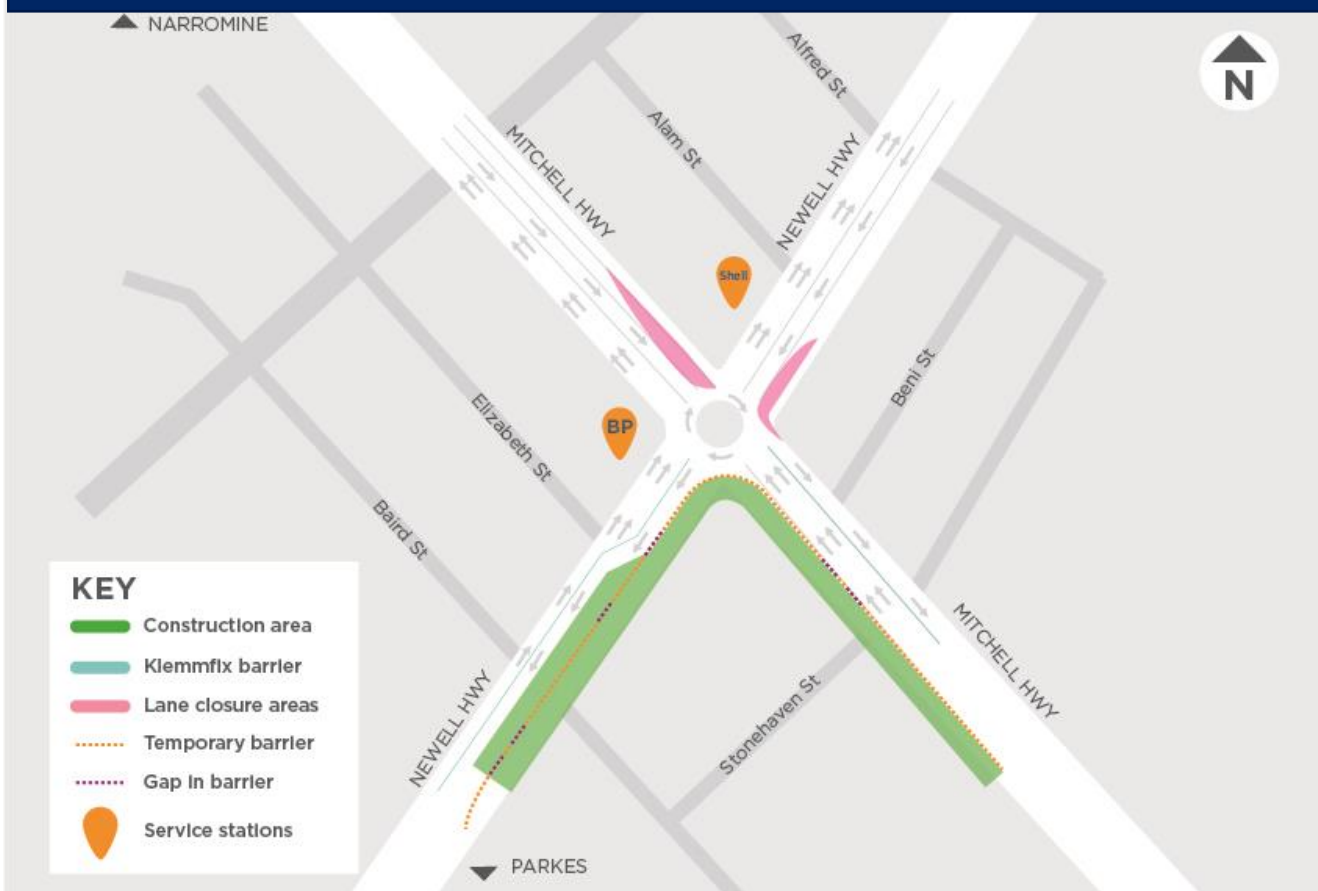


Changed traffic conditions at the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection, Dubbo from Thursday 15 April 2021

The NSW Government is funding \$20 million to upgrade the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection to improve safety and efficiency.

Changed traffic conditions – Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection



From **Thursday 15 April 2021**, Transport for NSW will start pavement investigation work on the eastern side of the Newell Highway and northern side of the Mitchell Highway ahead of building the new pavement from **Tuesday 27 April 2021**.

Changed traffic conditions are expected to be in place for five weeks, from **Thursday 15 April 2021**, weather permitting.

Work hours will be between **7am and 5pm Monday to Saturday**, weather permitting.

There will be some night work for four nights between **8pm and 6am** from **Sunday 11 April 2021** to **Wednesday 14 April 2021**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some work carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and motorists. It may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise the impact, including completing the noisier tasks earlier in the night and staging the work along different parts of the work zone to minimise disruption in the same area. Transport for NSW will notify the community prior to any night work taking place.

Residents inside the traffic control area will still be able to access their property, however access arrangements may be affected. The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

Changed traffic conditions including temporary traffic control, reduced lane widths, restricted right-hand turn access, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists.

Motorists are advised to allow an additional five minutes travel time, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
