


Utility relocation on the Mitchell Highway and Newell Highway, Dubbo from Sunday 19 July

The NSW Government is funding \$20 million to upgrade the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway intersection to improve safety and efficiency.



The existing roundabout at the intersection of the Newell Highway and Mitchell Highway will be removed and replaced with traffic lights. The intersection will also be widened as part of the safety improvements.

There will be drainage relocations and new drainage infrastructure constructed at the Mitchell Highway and Newell Highway intersection, as well as near the intersection of the Newell Highway and Baird Street.

Night construction work is scheduled from Sunday 19 July 2020, for two weeks, weather permitting. Work is scheduled at night to minimise the impact to local residents and businesses, as well as for the safety of motorists and workers.

Drainage utility relocation work on the Mitchell Highway and Newell Highway near the intersection will be carried out at night between **6pm** and **6am** from **Sunday to Thursday** for two weeks from **Sunday 19 July 2020**.

Drainage work will also take place at the intersection of the Newell Highway and Baird Street between **6pm** and **6am** from **Sunday to Thursday** from **Sunday 26 July 2020**.

This drainage relocation work is scheduled after hours to minimise the impact to local residents and businesses as well as for the safety of motorists and workers. Transport will continue to notify the community about the timeframe of any upcoming construction activities. This night work is expected to take two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

We will notify you in advance and make every effort to minimise community impact wherever possible.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Where possible all impacts will be minimised and we will consult with you directly if some temporary changes are necessary.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic control measures in place to ensure the work zone is safe. There will be reduced lane widths and lane closures near the work during this time. There will be a reduced speed limit of 40km/h near the work and safety barriers will be used in some locations for the safety of workers and motorists.
