

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Temporary traffic changes at night on Warringah Road from Friday 6 March

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Warringah Road as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project

We recently informed you about temporary traffic changes along **Warringah Road** from **Tuesday 18 February** to **Wednesday 19 February 2020**, weather permitting.

Due to recent wet weather, this work has been postponed to Friday 6 March, weather permitting.

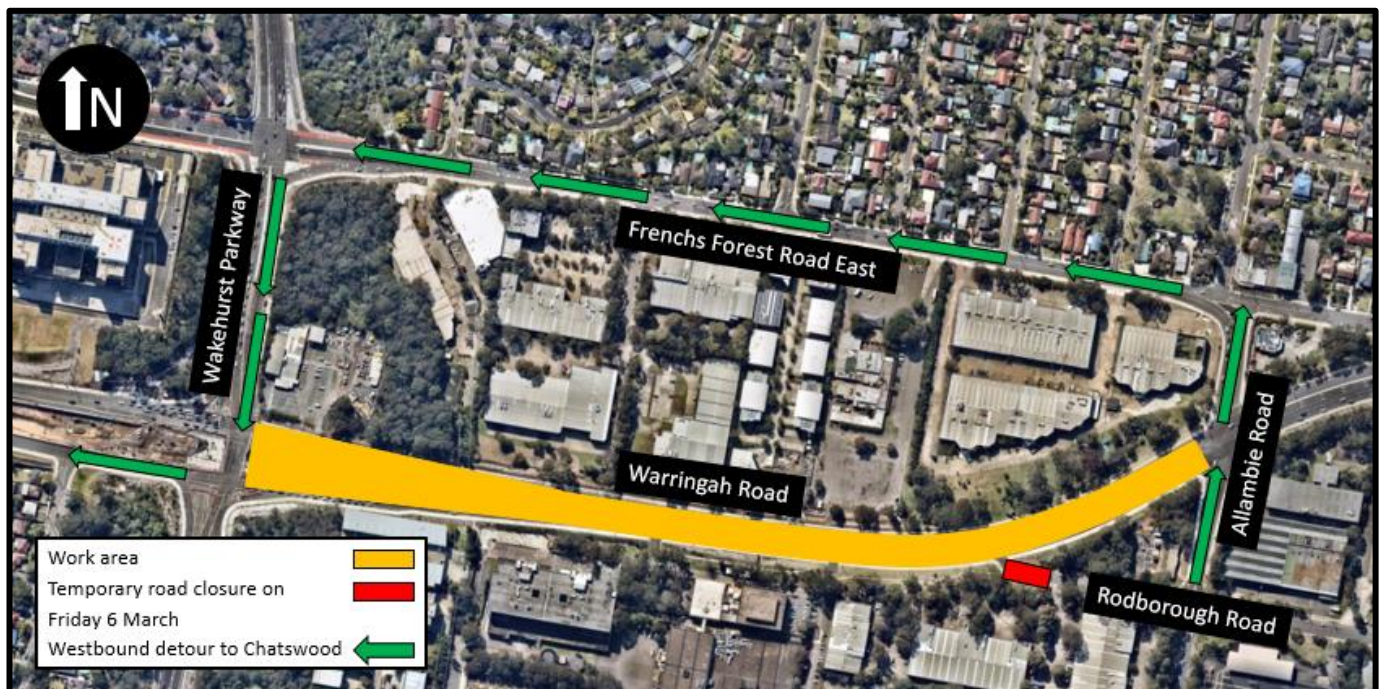
Warringah Road night work

From **8pm Friday 6 March** to **7am Saturday 7 March**, we will close all westbound lanes of Warringah Road from Wakehurst Parkway to Allambie Road and Warringah Road westbound traffic will be moved to an eastbound lane in a contra flow arrangement

During this time, there will be no access to Warringah Road from Rodborough Road. Detours will be in place and access will be maintained to businesses.

While this work is completed, we will turn off the traffic lights at the Wakehurst Parkway and Allambie Road intersections of Warringah Road. Police will be onsite directing traffic during this time.

What will the work involve?

The work involves:

- temporary lane and road closures
- asphaltting and line marking.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where possible and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will focus lights only on the working area. However, there is likely to be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.

Access to the Innovation Business Park will be available via Aquatic Drive.

Delays may occur along Warringah Road, Wakehurst Parkway and Allambie Road. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes are needed to ensure the safety of workers and road users and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and bus routes will not be impacted.
