

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Traffic changes at Warringah Road and Allambie Road intersection from Monday 19 August

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading **Warringah Road** and **Allambie Road** as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project.


To continue this work, traffic changes will take place at the intersection of **Warringah Road** and **Allambie Road** from **8pm Monday 19 August**, weather permitting.

Traffic changes from 8pm Monday 19 August to 5am Wednesday 21 August

From **8pm Monday 19 August** to **5am Tuesday 20 August** and **8pm Tuesday 20 August** to **5am Wednesday 21 August**, all northbound lanes on Allambie Road from Rodborough Road to Warringah Road will be closed. During this time:

- one lane will remain open for southbound traffic on Allambie Road
- one of the right turn lanes from Warringah Road to Allambie Road will be closed
- two of the westbound lanes on Warringah Road will be closed
- the kerb side lane on Allambie Road (southbound), north of Warringah Road will be closed. Southbound traffic should keep to the right

Allambie Road northbound motorists who wish to continue north or turn right to Warringah Road eastbound will need to detour via Rodborough Road, Warringah Road, Forest Way, Naree Road and Frenchs Forest Road West and East.

Traffic changes from 8pm Saturday 24 August

From **8pm Saturday 24 August** to **5am Sunday 25 August**, we will turn off the traffic lights at the intersection of **Warringah Road** and **Allambie Road** while we rearrange the intersection. Police will be onsite directing traffic during this time.

When the traffic changes are complete on Sunday morning, the intersection will include two right turn lanes from Allambie Road northbound to Warringah Road eastbound and three eastbound lanes on Warringah Road at Allambie Road.

Impacts to road users

There may be potential delays in this area including on Warringah Road, Allambie Road and Rodborough Road. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra time.

Detours, traffic management and signage will be in place to assist motorists through these temporary conditions. Please follow the directions of signage and keep to speed limits while this traffic arrangement is in place.

The temporary traffic changes are needed to upgrade the road and to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

What will the work involve?

The work involves:

- milling and road resurfacing
- asphaltting and line marking
- removing temporary barriers
- moving and setting up new traffic lights.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where appropriate and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use.
