

## Night work on Forest Way and Russell Avenue, Frenchs Forest from Sunday 17 January

**The NSW Government is funding the \$500 million Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade to provide customers with a better travel experience, increased capacity on the road network and improved access through the area for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.**

Roads and Maritime Services needs to relocate a number of utilities to make way for the road upgrades. To minimise the impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of workers and road users, some of this work will need to be carried out at night.

Night work will take place:

- Along Forest Way between Naree Road and south of Russell Avenue
- Along Russell Avenue between Grace Avenue and Forest Way.

This work will involve:

- Setting up traffic controls and equipment on the footpath and road
- Underground drilling to make way for new pipes.

There will be up to **eight shifts** of night work between **Sunday 17 January** and **Monday 15 February 2016**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **6pm** to **7am**.

There will be no interruptions to services during this work.

### How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and using flexible noise shields to dampen noise generated by investigation activities. We will carry out the work in shifts so you will not be affected for more than three consecutive nights.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. There will also be some temporary changes to pedestrian access around the work site during drilling. Traffic controllers will escort pedestrians safely around the work site. Access to driveways will be maintained at all times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction
