Sportsmans Creek new bridge project – Out of hours work

The NSW Government is funding this \$27 million bridge project as part of the Bridges for the Bush program to improve road safety and traffic efficiency.

Roads and Maritime Services has contracted Delaney Civil Pty Ltd to build the Sportsmans Creek new bridge. Work started in July 2016, and the bridge is expected to open to traffic in 2018, weather permitting.

In order to carry out some of the upcoming activities for the new bridge, we are proposing to work outside the project's approved work hours.

The approved work hours are from 7am to 6pm weekdays, and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

How will the work affect you?

The out of hours work will take place on **Thursdays, 12, 19 and 26 October 2017, between 5am and 7am**, and will help us complete concrete work before the expected high temperatures during the day.

The out of hours work will take place on the southern side of the bridge and will include:

- 5am to 6am – workers arrive on site and set up concrete pump
- 6am to 7am – concrete trucks start to arrive and concrete pour starts, including compacting concrete using vibrating equipment

What to expect during the work

- Light and heavy construction vehicle movements including concrete pump and concrete trucks
- Flashing lights on vehicles
- Equipment, including vibrating compaction tools and generators
- Artificial lighting at work area only

Every effort will be made to minimise any noise associated with these activities.
