

Full road closure on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview from Tuesday 19 July

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to provide continued access through natural disaster affected areas.

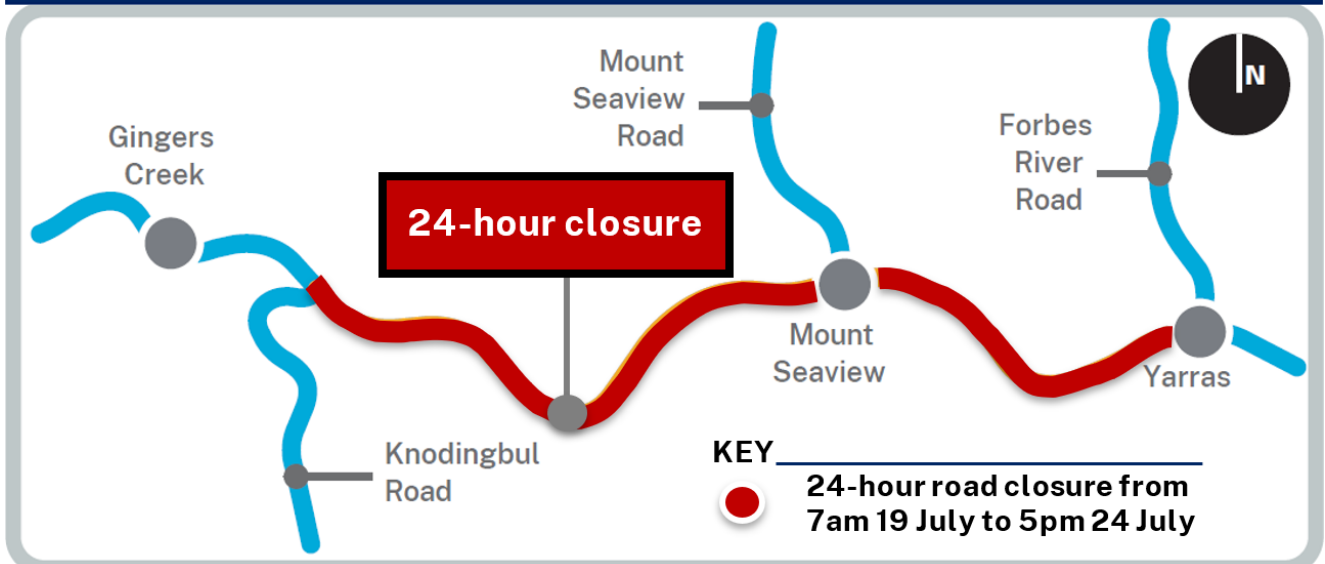
Transport for NSW is continuing major restoration work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to reinstate the road to pre-2021 flood condition.

We need to remove a significant amount of landslide debris from a landslip site before it deteriorates. To do this safely we need to close the road.

The Oxley Highway will be closed for **six days**, between **Knodingbul and Forbes River roads**, starting from **7am Tuesday 19 July** to **5pm Sunday 24 July**, weather permitting.

We will continue to work with our contractor partners to reduce road closures and minimise traffic impacts to motorists, where possible.

How will the work affect you?

The Oxley Highway between Knodingbul and Forbes River roads will be closed in both directions for six days, from 7am 19 July to 5pm 24 July.

Residents affected by this closure will be contacted by the project team.

We encourage motorists to check for traffic updates through livetraffic.com, electronic message signs and sign up for SMS alert for emergency and planned closures.

Please follow the direction of traffic controllers who will be present at the road closure points.

Plan an alternative route via Waterfall Way or New England Highway if your trip must take place during the closure period.
