

Oxley Highway

Important information – Oxley Highway reopens

The section of the Oxley Highway between Mount Seaview and the Gingers Creek Roadhouse has reopened to traffic, with a few sections operating under single lane with alternating flow arrangements, following multiple landslips from severe weather in March.

Work to restore the highway to its pre-flood condition is continuing and traffic control will remain in place. Restoration and improvement work may take up to two years to complete.

During that time there will be short periods where we need to fully close the road to carry out repair and improvement work safely or for further emergency work. We will endeavour to provide as much notice as possible to the community and affected businesses and carry out works as quickly as possible to minimise the impact.

Please note, these alerts will only advise about closures between Mt Seaview Road and Gingers Creek Roadhouse.
