

Oxley Highway upgrade, Rosewood from Monday 14 May

The NSW Government is funding a \$15 million upgrade of the Oxley Highway between Rosewood and Paddock road, about five kilometres west of Wauchope, to improve safety and traffic efficiency.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out the work, which includes:

- Removing dangerous bends by realigning the road
- Widening the road shoulders
- Improving drainage
- Installing new safety barriers.

We have included a map to show you the location of the work and the new alignment.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Saturday** and expect to complete the project in **18 months**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise and dust. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts during construction.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane, alternate flow at times during work hours.

For the safety of motorists and workers, speed will be reduced to 60km/h, 24 hours a day through the work site for the duration of the project. The speed limit will be reduced at times to 40km/h depending on the activity.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.
