

Temporary traffic changes on Oxley Highway, Mount Seaview

February 2022

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on the Oxley Highway at Mount Seaview to provide continued access through natural disaster affected areas.

Transport for NSW is continuing restoration and improvement work at the section of the Oxley Highway between Gingers Creek Roadhouse and Yarras, following multiple landslips from severe weather in March 2021.

We will be removing landslide debris at two sites between Mount Seaview and Yarras to improve safety. Due to the unstable condition of the slope, Transport will be using a remote controlled excavator to carry out the work.

Work will be carried out on **Monday 14 March**, between **7am** and **5pm**. This work is expected to take **four days** to complete, weather permitting.

Motorists will be kept informed about dates for these traffic changes through electronic message signs, live traffic and SMS notifications. How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Traffic changes

To manage queuing and safety, there will be some temporary traffic changes including reduced speed limits, lane closures and short stoppages, which may affect travel times.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.
