### Intersection Improvements on the Great Western Highway between Pitt Street and Marsden Street, Parramatta



The NSW Government is funding this work as part of its \$30 million Parramatta Congestion Improvement Program.

Roads and Maritime Services is improving the intersections of Pitt Street and Marsden Street along the Great Western Highway, Parramatta.

We need to close two sections of Marsden Street, either side of the Great Western Highway, for two night shifts from Sunday 2 June.

### Community benefits

- Improving access to and from the Parramatta CBD.
- Addressing increased traffic on the surrounding road network.
- Increasing safety for all road users
- Reducing queue lengths and increase through traffic
- Facilitating growth and development in Parramatta and surrounding areas.

## Our work schedule

Between **May** and **June** we will be working up to **six days** and **five nights a week**.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

We will not be working public holidays.

## Work to date

Since our last project update we have completed:

- all utility relocations
- the new watermain cutover
- construction of dedicated left turn lane onto Pitt Street from Great Western Highway.

## Traffic changes and lane closures

We will close **Marsden Street** between **Campbell Street** and **Great Western Highway** and between **Great Western Highway** and **Early Street** for up to **two night shifts** between **Sunday 2 June** and **Tuesday 4 June**.

The closures will be in place for our standard night shift hours.

Traffic management and signs will be in place to assist motorists with the changed conditions.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although temporary detours may be in place.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
