

# High Street Pop-up Cycleway

## Transforming Sydney's streets to protect your health

December 2020

Transport for NSW, in consultation with Randwick City Council, is delivering a new pop-up cycleway as part of the NSW Government's response to COVID-19. This will give you more options to travel safely, including to and from the University of NSW and the Royal Randwick Racecourse.

### What happens next?

We are installing a pop-up cycleway on the northern side of High Street from Anzac Parade to Wansey Road, Randwick.

Between Anzac Parade and the entry to Royal Randwick Racecourse the pop-up cycleway will be a shared path with pedestrians.

From the racecourse entrance to near the corner of Wansey Road it will be a separated cycleway, with one lane going in each direction placed between the kerb and travel lanes.

Close to the corner of Wansey Road, the pop-up cycleway becomes a shared path to connect to the existing cycleway on this street.

To accommodate the pop-up cycleway, parking spaces on the northern side of High Street between Anzac Parade and Wansey Road will be removed.

### When does the work start?

Work to install the separated cycleway will start from Monday 14 December 2020 and is planned to be completed by February 2021. Most of the work will occur during the day, weather permitting.

During this work, motorists are asked to follow the signs, including reduced speed limits, and to follow the direction of traffic controllers. Minor delays are expected due to changed traffic conditions.

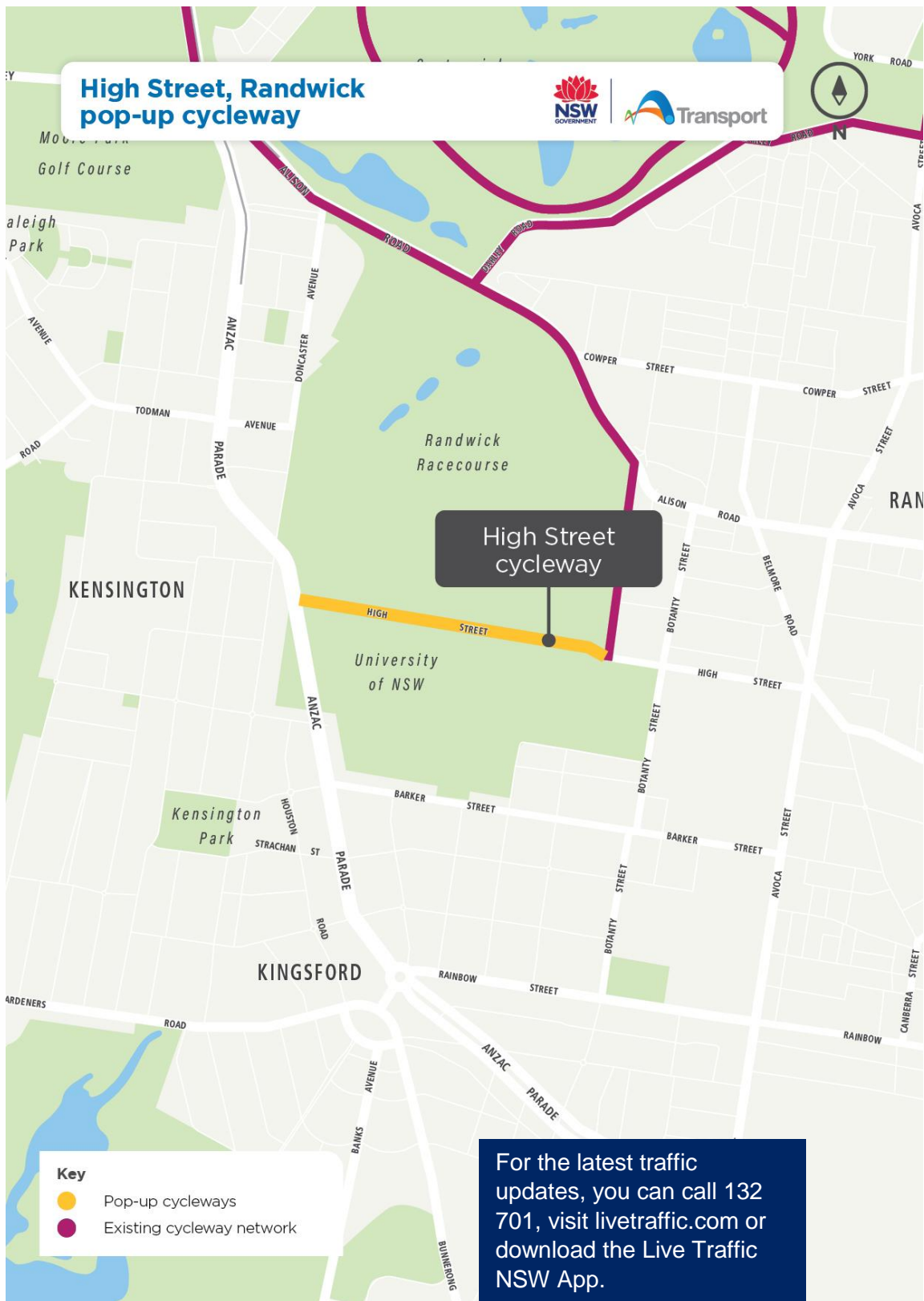
