

Work starting on the upgrade of intersection at Box Road and Princes Highway, Sylvania.

April 2021

The Gateway to the South Pinch Points Program aims to ease congestion and improve journey reliability on Sydney's key southern corridors. This project will improve bus operations, particularly for the 970 Hurstville to Miranda bus service.

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersection of Box Road and Princes Highway in Sylvania. In 2020, we consulted the community and finalised the design. We'll soon start work to ease congestion and improve traffic flow, travel times and road safety.

The project features:

- A dedicated right turn, through and left turn lanes on the eastern approach to Box Road
- A dedicated right turn bay on the western side of Box Road
- Extend existing 'no stopping' zone on Box Road
- Removal of two street trees
- New signalised pedestrian crossing and relocating existing pedestrian crossings
- Modification to service road access
- Removal of speed camera and installation of CCTV

Asbestos may be discovered in the ground in the project area as the project progresses. If we identify asbestos, we will implement an asbestos management plan which details safe work practices and will ensure all work is managed to strict Environment Protection Authority requirements.

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.
