

Intersection upgrade at Box Road and Princes Highway, Sylvania nearing completion

Community update | May 2022

In our last update in March 2022, we informed you that we expected the project to be completed by **end of May 2022**. Work has been slowed down due to intermittent rains in March and April 2022 and we now expect work to be completed at the **end of July 2022**.

The improvements would help reduce delays for bus services and motorists, while improving safety and pedestrian access at this intersection. The upgrade is part of the Gateway to the South Pinch Points Program.

Work completed

Between March and April 2022, we have completed:

- utility and service relocations
- traffic signal and storm water drain works
- widening of Box Road
- footpath, kerb and gutter works.

Work coming up

From 31 May to end of July 2022, we will:

- complete asphaltting and road markings
- open the new turning lines on Box Road
- tidy up the site and remove our temporary site sheds.



Our work schedule

Between **Tuesday 31 May** and **Sunday 31 July 2022**, we plan to work up to **43 day** shifts and **45 night** shifts, weather and site conditions permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturday** between **8am** and **1pm**. Our night work hours will be between **7pm** to **5am**, up to **five nights per week**. We will not work on Sundays, Queen's Birthday (13 June) or during heavy rains.

How will the work affect you?

There will be noise and disruptions associated with our work. We will do everything we can to reduce the disturbance to the community including completing the noisier tasks such as jackhammering and concrete saw cutting by **midnight**.

Traffic changes

There will be intermittent changed traffic conditions at the intersection during our work, for the safety of our workers and road users.

- There may be partial or full road closures.
- Residential access will be maintained, however there may be detours in place.
- Emergency service access will be maintained at all times.
- There may also be partial closure of footpaths in the work areas and clearly marked pedestrian detours will be provided.
- Bus 970 services between Hurstville and Miranda will run as normal.
