


Start of work: Princes Highway and The Boulevarde, Kirrawee

Transport for NSW | March 2020



On 2 April 2020 Transport for NSW will begin work to upgrade the intersection of Princes Highway and The Boulevarde, Kirrawee.

What we are doing

The project includes:

- re-location of utilities and services
- widening the intersection to accommodate two right-turn lanes and exit lanes northbound from The Boulevarde into Princes Highway
- extending the left slip lane from Princes Highway onto The Boulevarde (eastbound)
- constructing a traffic island to improve pedestrian safety and to separate traffic turning left and right from The Boulevarde into Princes Highway
- closing the service road exit to motor vehicle traffic at The Boulevarde (continued through access for cyclists and pedestrians)
- removing trees installing new kerbs and pavement, relocating utilities, asphaltting and line marking.

Our work schedule

Due to high traffic volumes, construction will mainly be carried out at night. Our schedule involves working up to five nights a week between **2 April 2020** and **early-2021**, weather permitting, excluding public holidays.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. Our day work hours are from **7am** to **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday**, and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Site compound

Our site compound throughout the construction of this project will be located at the intersection of The Kingsway and Sylvania Road. The compound will be used for site offices, and to store materials and machinery and may be in use any time work is taking place on the intersection of Princes Highway and The Boulevarde.

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities, such as concrete cutting, chain sawing and jack hammering, by midnight.

We are not carrying out construction work at the site compound. We won't be jackhammering, drilling, concreting or making other loud construction noise.

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
