

Intersection upgrade: Princes Highway and The Boulevarde, Kirrawee

End of work

Transport for NSW has recently completed improvements to the intersection of the Princes Highway and The Boulevarde, Kirrawee.

Funded under the NSW Government's \$300 million Gateway to the South Pinch Point Program. The project has improved the traffic flow at the intersection, providing a more reliable and safer journey for all road users.

The completed work:

- Widened the north-eastern and south-eastern sides of the intersection to accommodate two right turn lanes from The Boulevarde onto Princes Highway, northbound
- Widened the north side of the intersection to accommodate and extended merge lane on Princes Highway, northbound
- Extended the left slip lane from Princes Highway onto The Boulevarde, eastbound
- Closed the Princes Highway service road to through traffic onto The Boulevarde
- Constructed a traffic island to improve pedestrian safety and separate traffic, turning left and right, from The Boulevarde onto Princes Highway
- Relocated utilities, installed new pavements and kerbs, asphaltting and line marking

We will come back in early 2021 to complete minor relocation work of Sydney Water Assets.

We will update the community early 2021 to inform on our work schedule and planned activities.

Project benefits

- Helping reduce congestion and improve journey times along the length of the Princes Highway corridor
- Improving the intersections efficiency
- Helping reduce the number of collisions involving vehicles and pedestrians
