

Site investigations are required to progress the Princes Highway upgrade between Jervis Bay Road and Sussex Inlet Road

Transport for NSW is carrying out this work to get a better understanding of the environmental conditions of the area. This will inform the design of the proposed Princes Highway upgrade to deliver safer, more efficient and more resilient journeys.

What are we doing?

Site investigation work is required on the Princes Highway and surrounding roads between **Wednesday 26 May and late August 2021**, weather permitting.

Work will include drilling or excavating holes to collect information on underground utilities, soil and rock conditions and ground surveys. The plant and machinery used will be an excavator, saw cutter, truck mounted drill rig, vacuum excavation truck and support vehicles.

Some work near the highway will be completed at night between **6:00pm to 5:00am from Monday to Friday** for the safety of workers and to minimise impacts on motorists. Night work will take place occasionally over the coming months.

Work being carried out away from the highway will be completed during the day **between 7:00am and 6:00pm from Monday to Friday**, to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents.

Will we be working near your property?

Residents with work being carried out on their properties will be contacted by the project team separately at least **five days** before the work is to commence, unless otherwise agreed by residents. The project team would provide more detail on when work is planned to start on or near your property, how long work may be required and explain any possible impacts of the work.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some additional noise and traffic disruptions due to these works. You will have access to and from your property at all times. Every effort to minimise disruption and noise will be undertaken while work is being carried out. This includes additional staff to deliver work more quickly, carrying out noisier work at more convenient times, minimising nights required where possible and using low impact machinery where possible and turning off machinery when not in use.

Traffic changes

Motorists are advised workers will be adjacent to the Princes Highway from next week to carry out this work. Workers will be in the area between Thursday 27 May and late August 2021.

At times, traffic control may be required at specific locations if work is carried out near the highway. Changed traffic conditions may be in place along the highway between Jervis Bay Road and Sussex Inlet Road at night time between **6:00pm** and **5.00am** Monday to Friday and during the day between **7:00am** and **6:00pm** from **Monday to Friday**.

To minimise impacts to motorists, traffic control will be in place intermittently and only in small sections of the highway at a time. This may affect travel times by up to five minutes. Work will avoid peak travel periods.

For the safety of workers and road users, a reduced speed limit of 40km/h may be in place and road shoulders may be closed at these specific sections of the highway.
