Princes Highway upgrade between Jervis Bay Road and Sussex Inlet Road

August 2021

In May 2021, the Federal Government announced \$400 million is being contributed towards the Jervis Bay Road to Sussex Inlet Road upgrade. An upgraded highway between Jervis Bay Road and Sussex Inlet Road is a priority project and part of Transport for NSW's plan to deliver a safe, reliable, efficient and better connected transport network.

What is happening?

Geotechnical investigations, utility and ground surveys, environmental and heritage investigations are being

carried out to get a better understanding of the environmental conditions of the project area.

Over **200 hours** have been spent on geotechnical investigations so far. Works are planned for over 170 locations along the corridor

Investigations inform the concept design and environmental assessment of the project.

Growing the region's economy

A key aim of the Princes Highway upgrade is to support the sustainable growth of the local economy, employment opportunities and population. As part of the environmental assessment, some local businesses will be surveyed to understand the social and economic impacts and benefits of the project and how it would change business operations during construction and when open to traffic.

This will inform the environmental assessment of the project and help us consider the needs of transport customers and the business community as we progress the design.

Next steps

Work is taking place to identify the preferred option and we are investigating opportunities for staged delivery of the upgrade. The preferred option will include more details on the corridor alignment, intersection types and how to access local roads and properties. The preferred option will be on display for community feedback later this year.
