

Pause to construction activities on Prospect Highway upgrade

The NSW Government is upgrading Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future demands on this corridor.

In line with new restrictions introduced by the NSW Government on Saturday 17 July 2021, the Prospect Highway early works will **be paused until 30 July 2021**, or as otherwise advised by NSW Health.

We are making arrangements to ensure our sites are closed up safely and securely, as quickly as possible.

From 7am Monday 19 July 2021 you will see our teams on site to implement essential environmental protection, safety and security measures. **This work will involve securing our site throughout the projects area.**

We will make every effort to minimise the time our workers spend on site tomorrow. Under the latest Public Health Order, and as detailed on the Infrastructure NSW site, urgent works are permitted (Infrastructure NSW: Response to COVID-19).

Our crews will comply with all NSW Health COVID regulations while they carry out these urgent works, and traffic control will be on site for driver and pedestrian safety.

Please be advised, you may see some workers attend the site intermittently to carry out essential and urgent environmental, safety and security activities while our construction work has paused. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Security checks
- Road inspections and maintenance as required
- Traffic control as required.

We will continue to monitor emails and the project information line and our teams will be available during standard construction hours to answer any questions.

We thank you for your patience and hope everyone stays safe over the next two weeks.
