

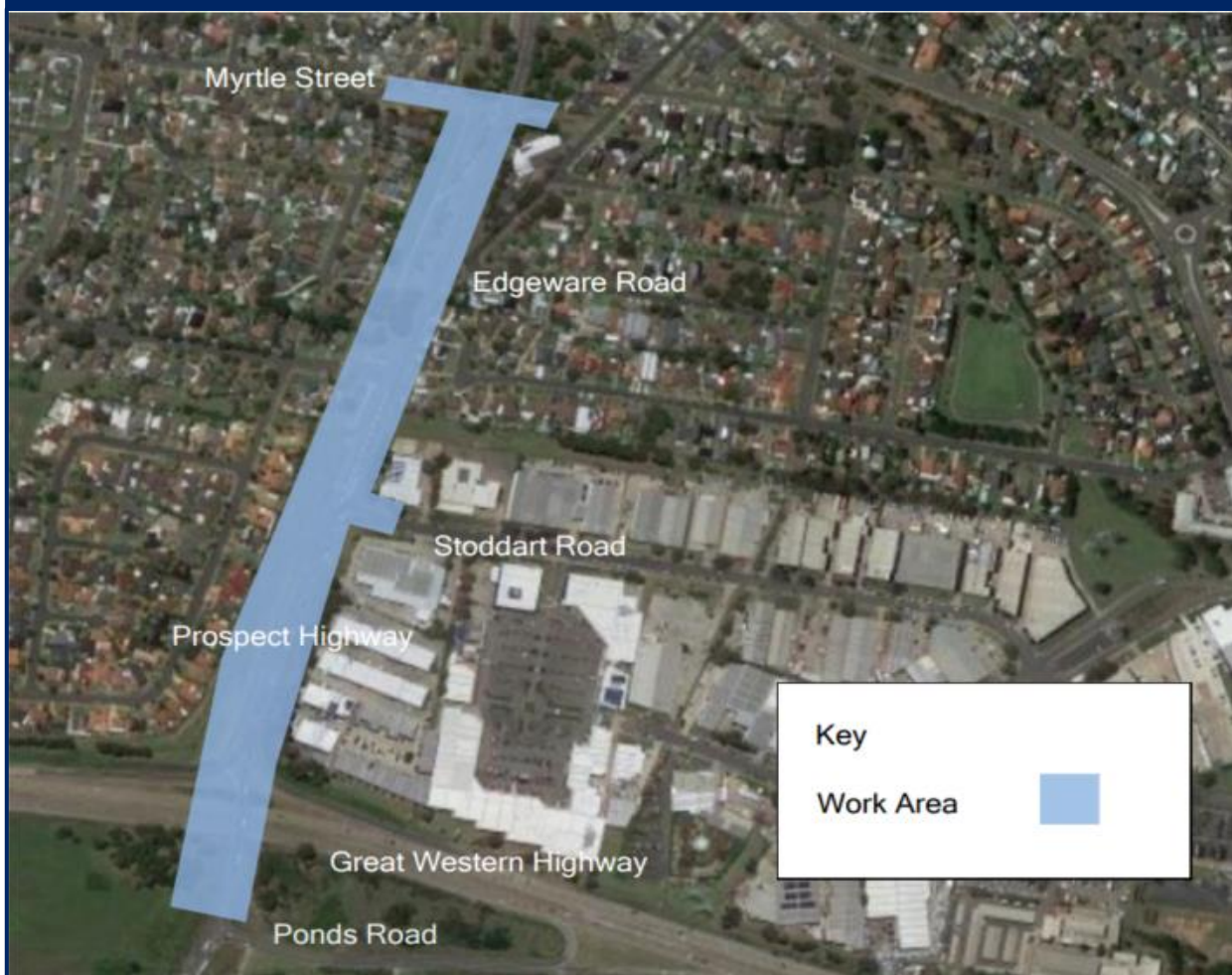
Night work along the Prospect Highway near Stoddart Road and Great Western Highway intersections, Prospect, from Thursday 1 April

The NSW Government is upgrading Prospect Highway between Reservoir Road, Prospect and St Martins Crescent, Blacktown to reduce congestion and help meet future demands on this corridor.

Transport for NSW has engaged Ausconnex to carry out early work on Prospect Highway between Blacktown Road and St Martins Crescent. Over the next 6 months, Ausconnex will carry out key utility relocation work required for the future upgrade.

We need to carry out some of this work at night to minimise the impact on traffic and improve safety for workers and road users. This work includes relocating the existing 33KV and 11KV electrical network near the Stoddart Road and Great Western Highway intersections with the Prospect Highway.

We will be onsite for up to **10 night shifts** between **Thursday 1 April** and **Friday 30 April**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be from **9pm to 5am**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times during the night time but we will do everything we can to minimise the impact of this work on surrounding residents and businesses. Any high noise impact works such as cutting the road asphalt will be undertaken before 11pm.

We will carry out this work in accordance with the NSW Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and the Environmental Protection Licence (EPL) requirements including the following respite conditions:

- no more than two consecutive evenings or nights per week; and
- no more than three evenings or nights per week; and
- no more than 10 evenings or nights per month.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
