Richmond Intersection Improvements – Stage 2 March Street and Bosworth Street, Richmond

The Australian and NSW governments are aiming to reduce congestion on Kurrajong Road, March Street and Bells Line of Road, on approach to Richmond Bridge. The Australian Government has committed \$18 million in funding to improve traffic conditions at three intersections.

Roads and Maritime completed Stage 1 work in October 2015 which included improvements to the intersection of Kurrajong Road and Old Kurrajong Road, Richmond. Roads and Maritime Services sought community feedback on Stage 2 in late 2015. Stage 2 includes work at the intersections of:

- March Street and Bosworth Street, Richmond
- Bells Line of Road and Grose Vale Road, North Richmond.

March and Bosworth streets, Richmond

We received comments from 12 people about the March and Bosworth streets proposal. Of these people, two were supportive, seven were neutral and four were against the proposal. They raised 37 matters including safety, parking, public transport and the proposal.

We received comments from 28 people about broader scope of the proposal. Of these people, five were supportive, 15 were neutral and eight were against the proposal. They raised 99 matters including safety, consultation, the proposal, and public transport.

Following a review of feedback, Roads and Maritime has decided to proceed with the proposal at the intersection of March Street and Bosworth Street, Richmond without change.

We thank everyone who provided comments and the community and stakeholders for considering the proposal.

Bells Line of Road and Grose Vale Road, North Richmond

We received comments from 106 people about the Bells Line of Road and Grose Vale Road intersection improvement proposal. Further breakdowns and analysis of this information will be provided in the Community Consultation Report for this proposal.


What happens next?
