Intersection improvements completed at March and Bosworth Streets, Richmond

The Australian and NSW governments funded this project to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion at the intersection of March and Bosworth Streets.

New dedicated right hand turn bay from March Street into Bosworth Street, Richmond



Transport for NSW has completed road widening work, including a new footpath and street landscaping, on March Street between Chapel and Bosworth Streets, Richmond.

We thank the community for their patience while we carried out this important work.

What we did

- Installed a new dedicated right turn bay and traffic signals for vehicles travelling east on March Street and turning right to travel south on Bosworth Street
- installed new signs and traffic signals so that vehicles travelling west on March Street no longer turn right on to Bosworth Street
- extended the 'No Stopping' and restricted parking zones on both sides of March Street between Chapel Street and approximately 100 metres east of Bosworth Street
- installed a new footpath on the northern side of March Street and new street landscaping along March Street between Chapel Street and Bosworth Street.
- completed adjustments to property and relocated services to make way for the widened road



Community benefits

The project is helping to:

- reduce congestion and improve traffic flow through the intersection and surrounding streets
- improve safety for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians
- improve access for freight and other heavy vehicles.
