Work is continuing on the March and Bosworth streets intersection upgrade, Richmond

The Australian and NSW governments are improving traffic flow and reducing congestion on the March and Bosworth streets intersection.

Transport for NSW recently completed property boundary adjustments and cleared the northern side of March Street between Bosworth and Chapel streets so we can move several underground services and the overhead power lines.

Our work aims to:

- reduce congestion and improve traffic flow through the intersection and surrounding streets
- improve safety for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians
- improve access for freight and other heavy vehicles.

Our work schedule

We will continue to work up to **five nights** a week in three week blocks from **late July to September**. Every fourth week we will only work up to **two nights** a week. We will write to you again before starting any extended periods of night work in October.

Our night work hours are between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday to Friday**, weather permitting.

Our day work hours are between **7am** and **6pm** **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Progress and the next stage of work

So far we have:

- adjusted property boundaries to make way for the widened intersection
- cleared vegetation and roped off areas on the northern side of March Street to make way for new utilities
- started work to lay new electrical, Telstra and NBN cables, and new watermains.

Work is continuing to:

- relocate overhead power lines and poles
- install new watermains, Telstra and NBN cables and gas services.

How will the work affect you?

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and motorists. We will complete noisier tasks such as saw-cutting concrete, jack-hammering and breaking up concrete by **midnight**.

Throughout the work, we will maintain all access to residents' driveways. However, there may be some delays when we are digging trenches in front of properties. Our traffic controllers will be on hand to safely guide residents in and out of their homes.

There will need to be some electrical outages in late July and early August. Endeavour Energy will manage this work and will send notifications directly to affected homes and businesses.

Traffic changes
