Work is continuing on the March and Bosworth streets intersection upgrade, Richmond.

The Australian and NSW governments are improving traffic flow and reducing congestion on the March and Bosworth streets intersection.

Transport for NSW recently completed the relocation of underground services and overhead power lines to make way for the new widened road. We are continuing work to relocate other services including a water main and telecommunication cables.

Our work aims to:

- reduce congestion and improve traffic flow through the intersection and surrounding streets
- improve safety for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians
- improve access for freight and other heavy vehicles.

Progress and the next stage of work

Since July we have:

- relocated underground gas pipes and overhead power lines
- laid new conduits for communication cables to be relocated
- started work to relocate a water main and communication cables.

From October to December we will:

- continue work to relocate the water main and communication cables
- prepare the site for road works to start including potholing investigations under the road surface, installing new drainage and creating a temporary footpath detour.

Our work schedule

We will work up to **five nights** a week during most weeks of **October**. From **November to April 2021** we will also work up to **five nights a week**.

Our night work hours are between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday to Friday**, weather permitting. Our day work hours are between **7am** and **6pm** **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**. We will not work on public holidays.

We will close down during the holiday period with no work taking place from Thursday 24 December to Sunday 3 January, inclusive.

How will the work affect you?

Some of our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and reduce safety risks to the workers and road users. We will complete the noisiest tasks such as saw-cutting concrete, jack-hammering and breaking up concrete by **midnight**.

Access to driveways will be maintained, however there may be some delays when we trench in front of properties. Our traffic controllers will be on hand to safely guide residents in and out of their homes.

Pedestrians will be directed to use a temporary footpath behind the work zone along the northern side of March Street, between Chapel and Bosworth Streets. This footpath will be reinstated at the end of the project.

Traffic changes
