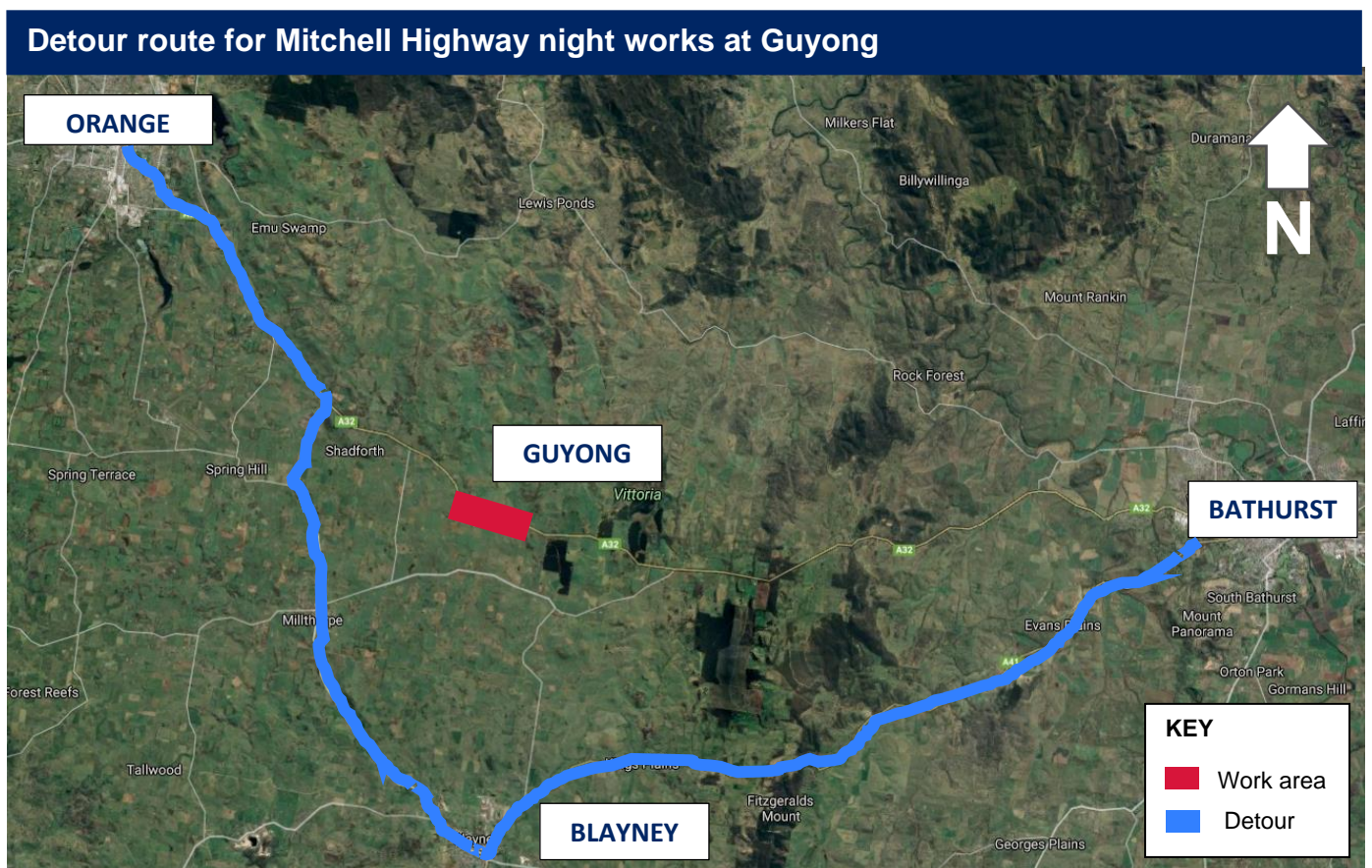


Changed traffic conditions for night works on the Mitchell Highway between Bathurst and Orange

The NSW Government is funding important safety upgrades on the Mitchell Highway at Guyong, 20km east of Orange from 8pm Sunday 13 September, with a detour in place.



From Sunday 13 September 2020, Transport for NSW will carry out night works on the Mitchell Highway at Guyong to install safety barriers. During work hours the detour route above will be in place.

This work is expected to take **5 nights** to complete, between **Sunday 13 and Thursday 17 September**, weather permitting.

Work hours will be between **8pm** and **3am** on these nights.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. All traffic will be diverted on the Mid-Western Highway via Blayney which will add an additional 15 minutes to travel times.
