

## Tree removal on Vale Road, Bathurst on Tuesday 15 September

Four Elm trees on the southern side of Vale Road have been identified for removal after a routine inspection by an arborist found them to be in a poor condition from natural aging and decay.



Bathurst Regional Council, on behalf of Transport for NSW, will carry out the work, which includes removing four Elm trees on Vale Road south of Bathurst. Removal of these trees will reduce the likelihood of future hazards and road closures and improve road safety. The map above shows the location of the works.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** on Tuesday 15 September and expect to be complete the work in **one day**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work area is safe. Single lane closure will be in place at each location when required, and a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr will be in place during work hours.
