We thank the community for the feedback we received on the Review of Environmental Factors proposal to upgrade the South Mosman Wharf, to make it accessible, safe and comfortable for everyone.

Community feedback is important and it will help to inform the detailed design and construction of the project.

Construction work to upgrade the wharf is expected to begin in the first half of 2022 and take about six months to complete (weather permitting). We will notify the community before starting work.
