The NSW Government is proposing to upgrade South Mosman Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program.

Transport for NSW sought comments from the community and key stakeholders on the proposed South Mosman Wharf Upgrade in May 2020. We would like to thank everyone who took the time to consider our proposal and provide feedback.

Following a review of the comments, we have prepared a Community Consultation Report summarising the feedback and our responses. A copy of this report is available at rms.nsw.gov.au/wharfupgrades, or by contacting the project team on the details below.

What you told us

Key feedback topics identified during the consultation period included:

- The safety of the existing stairs to the wharf
- The proposed uncovered gangway
- Potential impacts to visual amenity

In response to this feedback we can confirm that the existing stairs will be removed as part of the proposal. We will also investigate options to cover the gangway, stairs and lift platforms.

Visual amenity of the proposal will be assessed in the Review of Environmental Factors and refined further during detailed design. Every effort will be made to ensure that the proposal integrates into the environment and environmental impacts are minimised.

What happens next?

Feedback provided by key stakeholders and the community will help to inform the future planning of the project.

We will develop a Review of Environmental Factors for the proposal which will be publicly displayed for comment in late 2020.

We will continue to keep the community updated as the project progresses.
