

Intersection improvements on Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown

Start of work, Stage One

Roads and Maritime Services | June 2018

Roads and Maritime Services is starting improvement work along Stacey Street and Fairford Road in Bankstown to provide a safer, more reliable journey.

Improvements will be carried out in three stages, with stage one starting construction in June.

- **Stage one** includes the widening of the southbound lanes on Stacey Street between Macauley Avenue and Stanley Street and the extension of the existing dual right turn bay on Stacey Street for road users travelling right into Macauley Avenue
- **Stage two** includes the widening the northbound lanes on Stacey Street between Macauley Avenue and Stanley Street and improving the intersection of Stacey Street and Macauley Avenue
- **Stage three** includes the intersection improvements on Stacey Street and Stanley Street.

Key benefits

This work will allow for existing and future road users to save time while travelling through the road corridor, connecting you to southern Sydney, Sydney CBD and Sydney's west.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to **six days per week for 110 shifts**, and up to **five nights per week for 45 shifts** over a **25 week period** between **Thursday 29 June** and **Friday 21 December**, excluding public holidays, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** **Saturdays**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

The work for stage one will include:

- Widening of Stacey Street from the existing two lane arrangement to three through lanes between Salvia Avenue and Macauley Avenue
- Extension of right turn lane from Stacey Street into Macauley Avenue by 80 metre
- Installation of a safety barrier along the length between Stacey Street and the stormwater channel
- Installation of new stormwater pits and drainage along the shoulder side of Stacey Street
- Installation of a new kerb and channel along the shoulder side of Stacey Street
- Installation of new kerb ramps at the Stacey Street / Verbena Avenue intersection
- Relocation of street lighting poles
- Closure of the Stacey Street midblock crossing at Petunia Avenue.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks such as jackhammering, saw cutting and road resurfacing by **midnight** and include respite periods for residents where possible. We will also be using non-tonal reversing alarms on heavy vehicles, using smaller, quieter vehicles for work where possible, switching off equipment when not in use, and not allowing trucks to queue in the work zone, or along Stacey Street, and staging the work in different locations. Street parking in the work zone will be restricted during the night work hours.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times.
