

Weekend shutdown of Cahill Expressway from 9pm Friday 1 October to 5am Tuesday 5 October

Transport for NSW will close the Cahill Expressway to motorists from **9pm Friday 1 October to 5am Tuesday 5 October 2021**.

This is one of a series of upcoming closures to install new medians between lanes 6 and 7, to improve drainage, and resurface lanes 7 and 8.

How will the work affect you?

During the weekend closure we will work continuously.

Activities include removing the existing asphalt surface, cleaning the exposed concrete, identifying and sealing any cracks, priming the concrete deck and asphaltting.

Our work will be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact. Some noisy work has to be scheduled at night to accommodate vehicles using the bridge and for the safety of workers.

We anticipate Friday night will be the noisiest in the south, with jackhammering and grinding into the early hours of Saturday morning. From 10pm these noise levels may be as loud as a vacuum cleaner or food blender for a small number of residents.

Temporary detours and traffic advice

To create a safe work zone, changes to traffic will occur during this weekend closure.

The Cahill Expressway (lanes 7 and 8 of the bridge) will be closed at High Street, Kirribilli and motorists will be encouraged to use the Bradfield Highway (lanes 1 to 6 of the bridge). The Sydney Harbour Tunnel will remain open.

Vehicles detouring onto the Bradfield Highway will be able to join the Cahill Expressway at the southern end of the bridge to continue their journey.

Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.


