Our work

Roads and Maritime Services is relocating utilities along Greendale Road. Work will include trench digging to connect new Telstra cable to the existing network.

We will be using excavators, a tipper, vacuum truck, saw cutting machine and plate compactor to carry out this work.

Our work schedule

To minimise the impact on road users, work will take place between **7pm and 6am**, weather permitting, on:

- **Monday 25 February**
- **Tuesday 26 February**
- **Thursday 28 February**
- **Monday 4 March 2019.**

How will the work affect you?

Work will include using lighting towers that we will face away from residences. To reduce noise produced by machinery, noisier tasks will be carried out before midnight. Telstra connections will not be affected.
