

## Night work on Macquarie Street, Windsor, from Monday 29 January

**The NSW Government is funding this essential maintenance work under its \$1.5 billion program to maintain and improve the 18,028 kilometre state road network.**

Roads and Maritime Services will be removing and replacing asphalt and repainting road markings on Macquarie Street and Hawkesbury Valley Way.

Our maintenance work aims to prevent or minimise damage to roads from weather and wear and tear to make them safer, provide consistent driving conditions and reduce maintenance costs in the long term.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

### Our work schedule

In November 2017 Roads and Maritime distributed a notification to the community to advise of the upcoming work.

We are now ready to start work and will be onsite for up to **30 shifts** between **Monday 29 January** and **Tuesday 1 May**, weather permitting, excluding public holidays. Our work hours will be between **9pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

### How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **11pm**.

### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.
