

Work continuing at Woodville and Parramatta roads, Granville & Holroyd - November 2021 to February 2022

The NSW Government is widening and upgrading the intersection of Woodville Road and Parramatta Road in Granville and Holroyd. These improvements will help ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety on this section of Parramatta Road.

What's happened?

Since we started work in August, we have:

- Completed site establishment
- Carried out service investigations to locate existing underground pipes and cables
- Relocated an existing gas main
- Removed asbestos containing material
- Begun excavation work

What's next:

During November 2021 and February 2022, our work will include:

- Full-depth road pavement construction
- Installation of new traffic control signals
- Relocation of existing water pipes
- Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) work
- Lane adjustments and temporary line marking

How will the work affect you?

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. This may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

- Work will generate some high noise and our team will minimise impacts where possible, including completing noisier activities by midnight.
- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.
- Minor traffic disruptions will have traffic control measures in place.

Our work schedule in the months ahead

Between **Monday 1 November 2021** and **Monday 28 February 2022**, we will complete approximately 80 day shifts and 40 night shifts, site conditions and weather permitting. Our day work hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am until 1pm on Saturdays**. Our night work hours are **6pm until 5am the next day, Sunday to Thursday**. There will be **no night shifts on Fridays or Saturdays**. No work will take place on Sundays during the day or on public holidays. We cannot work during periods of heavy rainfall.
