

## Night work on Woodville and Guildford roads, Guildford from Wednesday 21 January

This project is part of the NSW Government's \$246 million Pinch Point Program, which aims to reduce traffic delays, manage congestion and maintain travel times on Sydney's major roads particularly during weekday peak periods.

### Thank you for your feedback

In November 2014, Roads and Maritime Services invited feedback from the community on a proposal to improve traffic flow and road user safety at the intersection of Woodville Road and Guildford Road.

Roads and Maritime thanks everyone who took the time to review the proposal and provide feedback. On the basis of community and stakeholder feedback, no changes to the proposal are required.

Following consultation, we have completed a detailed design and an environmental impact assessment. We now plan to start construction of the project.

### Project details

The project will provide a dedicated left-turn lane, a dedicated through lane and a dedicated right turn lane on Guildford Road at both the eastern and western approaches to Woodville Road. It will also provide a fourth pedestrian crossing across the northern approach to the intersection on Woodville Road. Work will include:

- Removing a tree, which has been identified as unsafe
- Installing a pram ramp
- Adjusting kerbs, gutter and drainage
- Relocating and upgrading traffic lights
- Removing the concrete centre median on Guildford Road
- Road resurfacing and utility adjustments
- Signage and line marking to complete the pedestrian crossing and new lane configuration.

The project will result in the removal of 15 parking spots on Guildford Road between Grassmere Street and Lough Avenue. We have provided a diagram to help you better understand the work.

This work will be carried out at **night** between **8pm and 5am** from **Wednesday 21 January for four months, excluding Saturdays**, weather permitting.

### Changed traffic conditions


Lane closures will be in place while the work is carried out to ensure the safety of road users and workers. Road users are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. Motorists may experience minor delays due to changed traffic conditions.

The location of bus stops and pedestrian access may be temporarily affected. Consultation is ongoing to identify the permanent location of bus stops. The community will be notified of any permanent changes.

There will be noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents and businesses.
